H) Any and all monies remaining shall be divided equally by and between the parties.

SECOND: Coming to the matter of personal property settlement, the parties agree as follows:

- B) Wife shall have the 1974 Chevrolet Vega, bearing Serial No.
- c) All household furnishings and appliances shall be divided equally by and between the parties, each party to receive personal property of approximate equal value. In the event there is a dispute as to any specific item, the wife shall have the first choice as to an individual item and an approximate valuation of same shall be established, whereupon, the Husband then can choose an individual item or items having an equal valuation. Any further disagreement as to possession of an individual item of personal property, the parties will alternate regarding who has first choice in receiving said item or items.

THIRD: Except as herein otherwise provided, each of the parties hereto agrees that the other may sell or dispose of his or her property by gift, deed, Last Will and Testament or otherwise, and that each shall be barred from any and all claims or rights of dower, years allowance, right to live in the mansion house, distributive share or interest share of the other party's estate, from any and all claims or rights as widow, widower, heir, distributee, survivor or next of kin, and any and all other
