This cause came on for hearing this 10th day of February, 1975, on the Complaint of the Plaintiff and the evidence offered by her. Present in court were Plaintiff and her attorney, ~~Christopher J. Newman~~ *Harold Stein*, Youngstown, Ohio. The Defendant was not present in person nor was he represented by counsel. The Court finds that the Defendant was properly served with service of process and a copy of the Complaint by certified mail, pursuant to Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure, and such service is hereby approved.

The Court finds that the Plaintiff had sufficient legal residence in this state and county at the time of institution of this action and that this Court, therefore, has jurisdiction of this cause and of the parties.
